Updated treasurer's report below:

- 1) The check account switched over and funds were moved from one account to the other. We do not have access to the one just yet. I used the information from the previous accounts statement which should be correct, but I may need to send out an update with the minutes. I took all stated expenses and then added back the amount withdrawn and the fees for overages and the numbers aligned. More to come if needed.
- 2) I went ahead and purchased the O365 subscription. It was a total of \$72.68. I added that to the adjustments in this month's numbers.
- 3) We need to set aside money for rent which will be due in June for the following year. It is normally \$550.00. I do not know if that will change based on a month to month agreement.
- 4) I have not been setup on the checking account yet. I did get the new checks from the bank through Lindsay H. and Jimmie received the new checking card.
- 5) I made a clerical error in my addition and recording of administrative expenses last month. Not sure what happened. I had stated that there were \$407.19 in expenses, but it was \$409.10. I verified the number against the statement and the receipts, everything was correct.

- 6) PI purchased an \$18.11 stamp. It was not reported at the last area. I reported it in the "Variation in costs".
- 7) Are we ok with \$10 being taken out for literature to use as change?
- 8) I need itemized reports, receipts and change for each sub-committee every month. I need to report how the funds are spent.
- 9) Friendly reminder to all new GSRs, please do not bring change. I have to count down to the penny and it sucks.

Assistant Treasurer: Helped review spreadsheet and expenses. Checked PO Box every month. Has flyers for other areas and events. Made an additional PO Box key and will pass it on to Area Chair. Requesting \$9 to reimburse for key.

RCM 1: Not much to report as most of you were at regional assembly. Here are some highlights, Guidelines were approved, CRCNA budget was approved. Web, P.I., and PR chair are all open at the regional level. Next Region should be May 19th in Denver, however, it's not on the regional calendar yet – once the date is confirmed, it will get blasted out. Disbursement requested for travel \$20.
