RCM1 report to OTW ASC 08/03/25

Dave and I both attended the July 20th regional mtg held on Zoom. Dave L. posted the upcoming August ASC dance to all, and it was also in the minutes. Another upcoming event is World Unity Day on Sept 5th- 6th. Running from 9 PM PDT on the 5th to 9 PM on the 6th, there will be speakers, workshops, and videos for the 24 hours plus a worldwide moment of silence at 9 am PDT (10 am MDT) where addicts worldwide will join together to say the Serenity prayer. Details at na.org/annual events. In a recent financial disclosure from the WSO it showed the Convention last Sept lost a million dollars. When and where the next one will be held is unclear at present. A decision was made to allow the posting of any and all NA related events on the regional calendar. It's a fairly easy process but if you need a walk



through let me know. We talked about the Regional Assembly in September to be a hybrid mtg physically held in Boulder. It is suggested that all GSR's attend. Budgets will be approved as well as new guidelines for H&I. Elections for the executive committees of future CRCNA, CCRMCO and WRCNA will be held. Please announce so local members can stand for regional service. Also, a timeline for the CAR/CAT will be discussed. At the CRSCNA itself, a vice-chair is needed. The Treasurer is heading an ad hoc to examine CRSC guidelines.

Speaking of the Treasurer, there was an opening balance of \$17,343.00 which leaves \$3,356 in unencumbered funds after figuring in annual budgets. After spending requests were met, \$2K was sent to the WSO, leaving \$40.

The June Campout had 131 attendees with lots of families with kids. They expect to cover the seed money for next year and possibly return \$1350+ to the region. They sold merch for the first time in many years. The women's retreat is very soon in Empire. All scholarships have been awarded. CRCNA revealed the marathon and workshop topics and all were approved.

If your Group or Area is holding an event (BBQ, dance, etc.), please send any contracts to CNAC for review and signature. This is to protect an individual addict from holding themselves liable if anything goes wrong. Also, and very important, if the event involves anything that can result in an injury (rafting, paintball, horseback riding, roller, or ice skating, etc.), please have all participants sign a Waiver Release Form to not hold CRSCNA responsible if they get hurt. We will be happy to provide the appropriate Waiver Form for your event. No regional mtg in May so not much to report. The main talking point is the Colorado Regional Rocky Mountain Campout next weekend in Leadville. They have merchandise for sale which is available at nacolorado.org. If you order a hoodie or t-shirt it be delivered after the campout. One can now pay in advance using a major credit card in addition to PayPal. Remember to dress warmly. The women's retreat in Empire in late August has scholarships available but probably for not much longer. Payment plans are available as well in 4 easy installments. Next regional meeting is a zoom only and September's assembly will be a hybrid with the location TBD.

Longview: Todd cannot make it his report: We have missed both meetings in July due to lack of available members (traveling, sickness, working out of state, etc.) Currently, we have 5 volunteers cleared to bring in meetings. We have 2 new volunteers who are willing, one submitted their ingot for the background check and another volunteer who is waiting for Longview HR to provide the background checks so they can complete it. This process takes a very long time for some members. WE were notified a few weeks ago by Longview that they are starting an adolescent group and that no additional volunteers can be cleared (including the 2 in the process) until new background check/requirements are established. We think a few members will not qualify given more restrictive requirements. The 5 cleared volunteers are allowed to continue to bring in meetings for a few months until the new process is in place.
